Licences and accompanying tags are a great way to reunite dogs with their owner and provide proof of a pet's rabies vaccination.

**Dog tag fees until March 31st are:**

**Spayed or Neutered - \$5  
Intact - \$10**

**Fees increase as of April 1st.**

**\*\*Must have proof of rabies vaccination\*\***

**FYI:** If your dog is caught running loose, impound fees range from \$30 for the first infraction, \$40 for the second & \$50 for the third plus a maintenance fee of \$5 per day.

NO DAYTIME BURNING ALLOWED AT ANY TIME DURING THE YEAR!**

**FIRE BANS**

During a fire ban, all fires, burns, including fireworks are prohibited.

**TRAILER BY-LAW**

PLEASE NOTE:

Trailer License By-law 2019-36 is in force, permits are required:

- **\$113 per trailer until March 31st**
- **\$169.50 per trailer April 1st and beyond**

**ROADS NOTICES:**

**Snow on Roadways**

Blowing or plowing snow from your property onto the street contravenes Section 181 of the Ontario Highway Act. When you are clearing snow from your driveway, please do not push the snow across the road. Your efforts in making winter driving and walking safe for everyone are appreciated.

**Driving**

When approaching a plow, reduce speed, keep your headlights on low, and stay to the right. If driving behind a plow, keep a safe distance (**stay back 200 feet**), and remember that the plow may need to back up. **If you can't see the mirrors, plow drivers can't see you!**

**Ongoing Projects:** brushing, culvert replacements, ditching and granular resurfacing.

**Please watch for signs & slow down for our Road Workers.**



**Water Issues:** If anyone views water across any road in the Township at any time, please call the Office at 705-785-3479.

**Half-Load Restrictions** are scheduled from March 1st - May 31st unless otherwise posted. Watch for signs.

**Weight Restriction:** Booth Bridge on West Road has a load limit of **10 Tonnes**.

Did you know that charges can be laid if you are caught dumping garbage in Plummer Township? Be a good neighbour - take your garbage to the Tri-Neighbours Site at 1314 East Line Road if you miss the pick-up day.

**PLEASE NOTE:**

Fridges and freezers **are not allowed** to be used as garbage storage containers.

**REMINDER:** Brush is accepted only at the Tri-Neighbours Site at 1314 East Line Road on Saturdays year-round **and** at the Thessalon Transfer Site on Fridays 3-7 pm from April 1 to October 31. When a Statutory Holiday falls on a Friday, the Thessalon site will forfeit that day of operation.

### Emergency Kit

#### Essentials

- Food (non-perishable and easy-to-prepare items, enough for 3 days) and a manual can opener
- Bottled water - 4 litres per person for each day
- Medication(s)
- Flashlight
- Radio (crank or battery-run)
- Extra batteries
- First-aid kit
- Candles and matches/lighter
- Hand sanitizer or moist towelettes
- Important papers (identification, contact lists, copies of prescriptions, etc.)
- Extra car keys and cash
- Whistle (to attract attention, if needed)
- Zip-lock bag (to keep things dry)
- Garbage bags

#### Special Considerations

- Items for babies and small children - diapers, formula, bottles, baby food, comfort items
- Prescription medication
- Medical supplies and equipment
- Pet food and supplies
- Any other items specific to your family's needs

#### During a flood:

**If you are instructed by emergency officials to evacuate, do so immediately. If an evacuation is not in place, consider these safety precautions:**

- Avoid travelling on roads that are near any bodies of water.
- Don't drive through, stand or walk in any moving water.
- If you must walk, look for still water and use a stick to check the ground in front of you.
- Keep children and pets away from floodwater.
- Avoid using the plumbing system if the septic tank or disposable system is under water.

#### During a storm:

**Take the following steps so you and your**

**family are prepared in the event of an emergency:**

- Have a safe room in your home where everyone gathers during a storm - away from windows, skylights and glass doors.
- If there's a tornado, gather in a basement, storm cellar or interior room on the lowest floor.
- Remove dead or rotting trees and branches that could fall and cause injury or damage.
- Bring inside or tie-down garbage cans and lawn furniture.
- Use surge protectors - a safety electrical plug that will shut off the power if lightning strikes to prevent damage to your computer and other household items.
